## REGISTRATION POLICIES

## Please read before registering. You are responsible for the information below.

- In the past we have allowed a 15 minute "grace period" for trainees who are running late, we will no longer allow that grace period. Going forward NO late arrivals will be accepted into the training.
- Parking lot gate & doors will lock at 6:30 PM on Tuesdays and at 9:00 AM on Saturdays
- We will be reviewing basic safety procedures at the beginning of each training session.
- Admission to trainings will begin at 6:15 PM on Tuesdays and at 8:45 AM on Saturdays.

### Training Policy

- Pre-registration is REQUIRED 3 days prior to all training sessions.

- Substitutes are allowed. You are responsible for calling the office at least 24 hours prior to your session if you cannot attend. If you do not call, you are considered a <u>NO SHOW</u>.

- You <u>MUST</u> attend the entire training to receive your certificate.
- You <u>MUST</u> provide a <u>48 Hour-Notice</u> if you need to cancel or change a registration for CPR & First Aid, Health & Safety, and Medication Administration. If we do not receive a notice and you are considered a <u>NO SHOW</u>, you will be responsible for the cost of the class next time you register for a spot.
